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Introduction

Although reincarnation is not typically an accepted philosophy in the modern Western worldview, growing evidence from past life regressions, personal accounts, and spiritual traditions suggests it may play a far more significant role in the human experience than previously acknowledged. Through the groundbreaking work of Dr. Brian Weiss (Many Lives, Many Masters), Dr. Michael Newton (Journey of Souls) and Dolores Cannon (Between Life and Death), there is a mountain of evidence showing that not only do we reincarnate, but we actually plan our incarnation before coming to earth. We pick our parents, we pick our birthdate, we even pick our name— with each element holding purpose and meaning for the journey ahead.

These three pioneers performed hypnosis on thousands of individuals. They never collaborated, worked in different decades and lived in separate parts of the United States. Their clients were also of varying backgrounds and beliefs. Yet they all shared strikingly similar stories about past lives, soul planning and reincarnation while under hypnosis.

The purpose of incarnating is for the evolution and growth of our soul. Our past lives greatly influence the planning of our incarnation. Earth is a very negative, difficult planet in which to live. That, and free will, can make living our planned life - not always go as planned. So we come back, and we try again. We choose to experience loss, love, unimaginable trauma. If we are rich in one life, we come back as poor in the next. We want to experience everything, because experience helps us grow. We make soul contracts with those we incarnate with—souls we've shared many lifetimes with, returning again to help each other grow, heal, and remember who we truly are. Sometimes those relationships are loving, sometimes they are difficult - but they always have a purpose.

We create a blueprint for our life. Numerology gives us a glimpse into that blueprint.

A Note on Resonance

Not every number in your chart will feel like a perfect match right away—and that's completely normal. People are layered and often carry seemingly opposite qualities at the same time. Confidence and self-doubt, independence and sensitivity, momentum and hesitation can all exist within the same person.

Each number exists on a spectrum of expression, and how it shows up can be shaped by personal growth, life experience, and the influence of other elements within the chart. What may feel contradictory is often a reflection of inner tension—and tension is often where growth occurs.

Your name, Master Numbers, and timing cycles also influence resonance. Some qualities may feel stronger or more accessible during certain phases of life, while others develop more gradually over time. A numerology chart is not meant to be lived all at once. It unfolds. Rather than viewing this profile as a list of fixed traits, think of it as a map of potentials, patterns, and growth themes. Trust what resonates now, stay curious about what doesn't, and allow room for complexity and change.

What Contributes to Alignment

Alignment occurs when the energy of a number is expressed in a healthy, conscious, and integrated way.

This often comes from:

- Self-awareness – Recognizing core traits and consciously choosing how to express them
- Life experience and maturity – Lessons learned through challenges that shape wisdom
- Supportive environment – Encouragement, role models, or relationships that reinforce healthy expression
- Balance with other numbers – Complementary traits from the full numerology chart help temper extremes
- Spiritual or emotional growth – Practices like reflection, therapy, journaling, or meditation that deepen understanding
- Sense of purpose – Feeling connected to a larger goal or mission aligns personal energy toward positive use

What Contributes to Misalignment

Misalignment occurs when a number's energy becomes distorted, suppressed, or exaggerated. This may be caused by:

- Fear or trauma – Unresolved wounds can cause defensive or compensatory behaviours
- Over-identification – Clinging too tightly to one part of identity (e.g., "I must always be in control")
- Imbalance with other numbers – Conflicting or dominant numbers can distort expression
- External pressure – Cultural, familial, or social expectations that go against natural tendencies
- Avoidance of growth – Refusing to evolve, challenge oneself, or take responsibility
- Repression – Denying or disowning aspects of self due to shame or conditioning

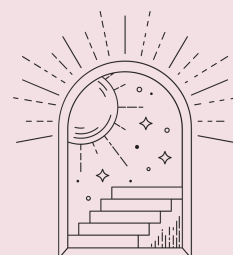


New phases do not always emerge at the same pace for everyone. Growth often depends on self-awareness, lived experience, and the integration of earlier lessons.

PINNACLE CYCLES



There are four Pinnacles, each bringing a different energy to the forefront of the journey during specific chapters of life. These cycles often shape what the soul is being called to develop, embody, pursue, strengthen, or step more fully into during that period of growth.



The First Pinnacle begins toward the end of the First Period Cycle, as the soul moves beyond foundational early development. Each spans nine years and is experienced through nine Personal Year Cycles, which shape the yearly rhythm and experiences within that chapter.

Personal Year Cycles create a repeating rhythm of movement throughout the journey, preventing the soul from becoming static or remaining fixed in one mode of experience for too long.
